## SPEEDWAY WEEKEND 2010

The following criteria have been set for the 2010 Racing Exhibit to be held at the Quincy Mall March 13th and 14th.

1. Reserved spots will be assigned for Quincy Raceways vehicles. **We will not be having any trucks, tractors, or boats this year.**
2. The Quincy Raceways track points champions in each class will have their choice of spot reserved. (After assigned spots).
3. Any stock car driver who wants to be next to their buddy must forfeit their draws and be assigned end spots. (Sears court)
4. ALL VEHICLES/DRIVERS THAT DIDN'T RUN 60% OF LAST YEARS SHOWS AND HAVE ASSIGNED SPOTS MUST BE READY TO ROLL IN AT 8:00 AM OR ELSE YOU WON'T GET IN AT ALL!
5. **PRE-REGISTRATION IS DUE BY MARCH 5<sup>TH</sup> and is required.**
6. On Wednesday, March 10th, 2010, 7:00 PM at Barneys, we will do the drawing for positions for the other pre-registered vehicles. By doing the drawing on Wednesday we will be able to estimate arrival and entry times. Everyone is welcome to attend the drawing, but it is not required. **THE TRACK REGISTRATION FORM MUST BE COMPLETED AND \$25 TRACK REGISTRATION FEE PAID IN FULL WITH THE MALL SHOW REGISTRATION. THE TRACK REGISTRATION WILL BE \$25 IF PAID BEFORE THE END OF THE MALL SHOW ON SUNDAY, MARCH 14<sup>TH</sup>. AFTER MARCH 14<sup>TH</sup> THE TRACK REGISTRATION FEE WILL BE \$35.**
7. All car owners must sign a hold harmless agreement the day of the show.
8. **No for sale signs will be allowed.**

### **BEWARE**

1. Anyone has who has not moved his truck and trailer out of the door area to the northeast corner of the mall lot (out by power substation) by 10:00 am will not be allowed to show next year.
2. Anyone who argues cries or cusses about their assigned spot will be ejected from the mall show immediately and the spot reassigned to someone else.
3. Please Call and cancel if you registered and can't make the show. Anyone who pre-registered and does not show up will forfeit his or her privilege to be an exhibitor in the mall show for the next two years.

## **DETAILS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR DISPLAYS AND VEHICLES** **WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The double doors will be open at 8:00 am Saturday, March 13th. (Doors are 9'10" high by 12' wide.)
2. Displays must be completely set up by no later than 9:30 am. **4' walkways must be kept open between vehicles.**
3. Sunday night at 5:00 PM will be the end of the exhibit. NO EXHIBIT WILL BE PERMITTED TO BE TAKEN DOWN OR MOVED BEFORE 5:00 PM.
4. Loading and unloading must not take place in the fire lane. Cars must be pushed inside. NOTE: Q-City Speedway, Inc. will not have the manpower to help you unload and push your vehicle in. You will be responsible for loading and unloading your own vehicles, so bring a couple of strong buddies. After unloading, trucks, trailers, tow vehicles, etc. must be parked to the far north of the parking lot (by east corner electrical sub-station.) REMEMBER: Doors will not open before 8:00 am.
5. Anyone having tables for display must have skirting to floor - - bring your own.
6. Electrical cords must be taped to floor with duct tape - - bring your own. NO SILICON SPRAYS (such as Amoral). If you Choose to Shine Your Tires (Amoral) do it outside.
7. Displays must be no wider than 8' and no longer than 10-10' (does not apply to cars.)
8. All cars must have **plastic underneath from bumper to bumper** - - bring your own.
9. Carpet pads must be under all wheels - - bring your own.
10. Batteries must be disconnected. All power steering hoses must be connected or sealed.
11. If you don't want anyone near your vehicle, you should have some type of professional looking stanchions, roping, or plastic chain. (You may want someone present at all times if you don't want anyone bothering your display.)
12. Clean and neat clothing is required and driver's uniform or team shirts are highly recommended. You want to look as professional as possible - - you never know when a potential sponsor may show up. REMEMBER: YOU ARE PROMOTING THE SPORT OF AUTO RACING. Be friendly to kids, in their eyes you are a star. Maybe even wear your new driving suit for a couple of hours, and hand out a little candy.
13. NO LAWN CHAIR CONVENTIONS, it only detracts from the professionalism we're trying to show.
14. No outside food can be carried in. If you can't get away to go eat, and someone brings you something to eat please be discreet with it.
15. **DO NOT START YOUR CAR INSIDE THE MALL!**
16. Be sure to let your sponsors know that your vehicle will be on display. Let them know you are representing their best interests and they will represent yours.

**DON'T FORGET YOUR PLASTIC, CARPET OR TILES, AND STRONG BUDDIES**

It is also a good idea to make a few informational type signs detailing for example the class of the car, drivers name and city, any titles won (and put those trophies and scrapbooks on display.) Make the signs as professional as possible and check you're spelling. Allow people to see what you have achieved in the sport. Pictures, photo albums, etc. are nice touches. If possible, use videos to show you racing.
